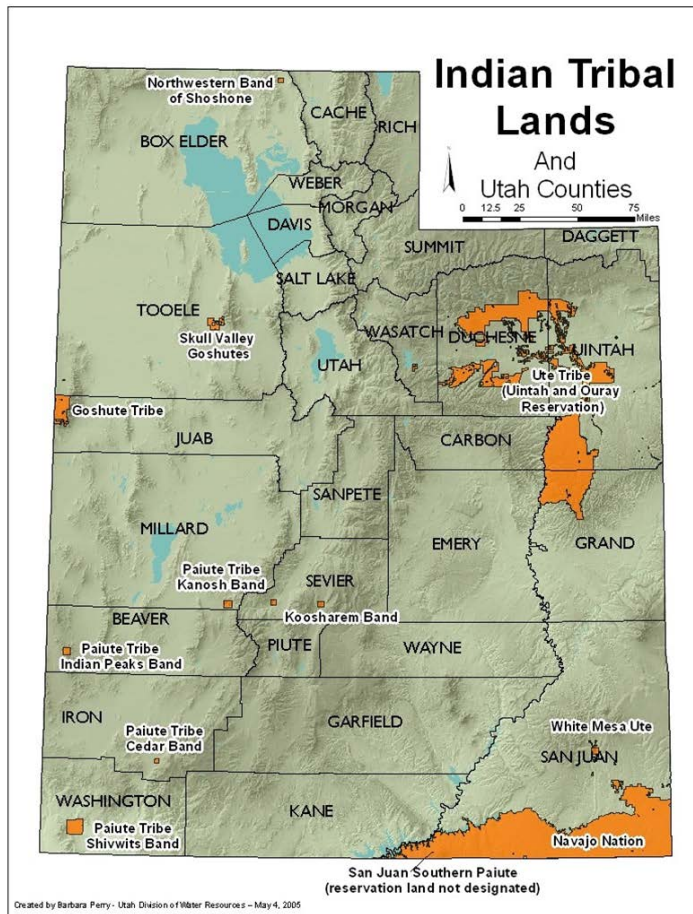

Tribal Consultation

- *Government to Government Relationship*
 - Constitution, Article I, Section 8 “Commerce Clause”
 - Treaties; cessation of acts of war
 - Snyder Act 1921; US gov’t. to provide health services in exchange for land
 - Supreme Court decisions
- *Presidential Executive Order: EO 13175, W.J. Clinton 4/29/94*
 - Memorandums, G. W. Bush 9/24/04, and B. Obama 11/5/09
- *Formal Consultation & Conferment Processes*
 - HHS; CDC, CMS, IHS, SAMSA, HRSA
- *ACA –Indian Health Care Improvement Act 2010*



Utah Recognition of formal Tribal Consultation

- Utah Division of Indian Affairs Act, Utah Annotated Code 1953, 9-9-104.6.
 - 2003 General Session, S.B. 100 defines the role of state agencies in the consultation process.
- UDOH Policy established 2004, signed 2006
- Indian Health Liaison Authorization Utah Annotated Code 9-9-104.6 and 26-7-2.5
 - 2011 General Session, SB 33 provides authority for the Department's Indian Health Liaison
- Governor Herbert's EO; EO/2014/005
 - directing State agencies to develop a formal process for consultation & ID a point of contact w/in each agency.



Utah Department of Health

- *Office of AI/AN Health Affairs*
 - Established 2011
 - Elevated to the Executive Directors Office 2017
- *Formal Tribal Consultation Policy & Process*
 - Updated, signed 2017; All 8 Tribal Governments & the Urban Indian Organization
- *Utah Indian Health Advisory Board (UIHAB)*
 - Established 1997
 - Tribally appointed representatives to work with state on any health or public health issue, policy, etc.
 - Meetings are held monthly
 - First step in Consultation Process
 - Priorities aligned with UDOH Strategic Plan and UHIP
